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# *An urban handbook of pleasures for those in search of the real thing*

Úbeda is no mere stop on the tourist trail, but a destination that asks to be courted with a lover's patience and a scholar's attention. Set in the lands of Jaén like a jewel nestled in a crown of olive groves, this World Heritage city is a living canvas where history is painted in Renaissance grandeur and in the quiet simplicity of traditions that have outwitted time with uncommon grace.

For the traveller in search of more than fleeting snapshots, Úbeda reveals itself as a landscape of sensations, where stone, earth and art are woven into an experience that leaves its mark on the soul as much as on the memory.

This chronicle is a compass for wayfarers, a guide that reaches beyond ordinary maps to uncover the essentials and bring to light the secrets that make Úbeda unlike anywhere else in the known world.





## *Ecstasy in Stone*

Plaza Vázquez de Molina and Its Jewels

The heart of Úbeda beats with titanic force in Plaza Vázquez de Molina, a space so arresting it steals the breath and stills the tongue. Here, a city's ambition takes shape in an architectural ensemble of harmony and beauty that defies description. There is no finer starting point for your romance with the city.



### *The Salvador Chapel: A Symphony in Stone*

Considered a masterpiece of the Andalusian Renaissance, the Salvador Chapel rises beyond its religious function to become a declaration of power, faith and creative genius. Its facade, born of Andrés de Vandelvir's imagination, is a symphony of classical forms in which every element seems to sing in perfect accord.

The central medallion calls to mind the grandeur of the ancient world with an

authority that never needs to raise its voice. Inside, conceived as the pantheon of the House of Cobos, the chapel astonishes with a monumentality that embraces without overwhelming. The sacristy, both intimate and majestic, is a masterpiece of light and proportion, where everything from the star-vaulted ceiling to the smallest ornament seems to whisper the secrets of Vandelvir's genius.

### *The Juan Vázquez de Molina Palace: Serene Elegance*

This palace, now home to the Town Hall, stands with quiet authority opposite Santa María Basilica. Its popular name comes from the chains adorning its facade, a symbol of royal protection that speaks of times when honour was carved into stone.

Pause to take in the purity of its lines, the beauty of its inner courtyard and the singular grace of its facade: a masterclass in serenity and balance that teaches more about architecture than many a learned treatise.



## *The Minor Basilica of Santa María de los Reales Alcázares: A Sacred Palimpsest*

On the site of the old main mosque stands this church, a true meeting point of eras where every century has left its signature.

To walk through it is to travel in time, from Gothic foundations to Renaissance transformations, a stone chronicle of civilisations

that succeeded one another without ever fully erasing what came before.

Its cloister is a haven of peace, the perfect place for a reflective pause, where the soul can quietly absorb this fusion of styles and centuries.





## *The City of Wise Hands*

A Journey Through the Creative Arts

The essence of Úbeda lies not only in carved stone, but in shaped clay, forged metal, wood and esparto grass. Craftsmanship is the city's vibrant soul, a living legacy that can be felt, touched and carried home as easily as it can be kept in the heart.

## *The Clay Route* *Temples of Pottery*

Make your way to the San Millán quarter, the epicentre of Úbeda's pottery tradition, where workshops are true temples of creation. Watching master potters at the wheel is a hypnotic spectacle, one that links the present to ancient rituals of transformation.

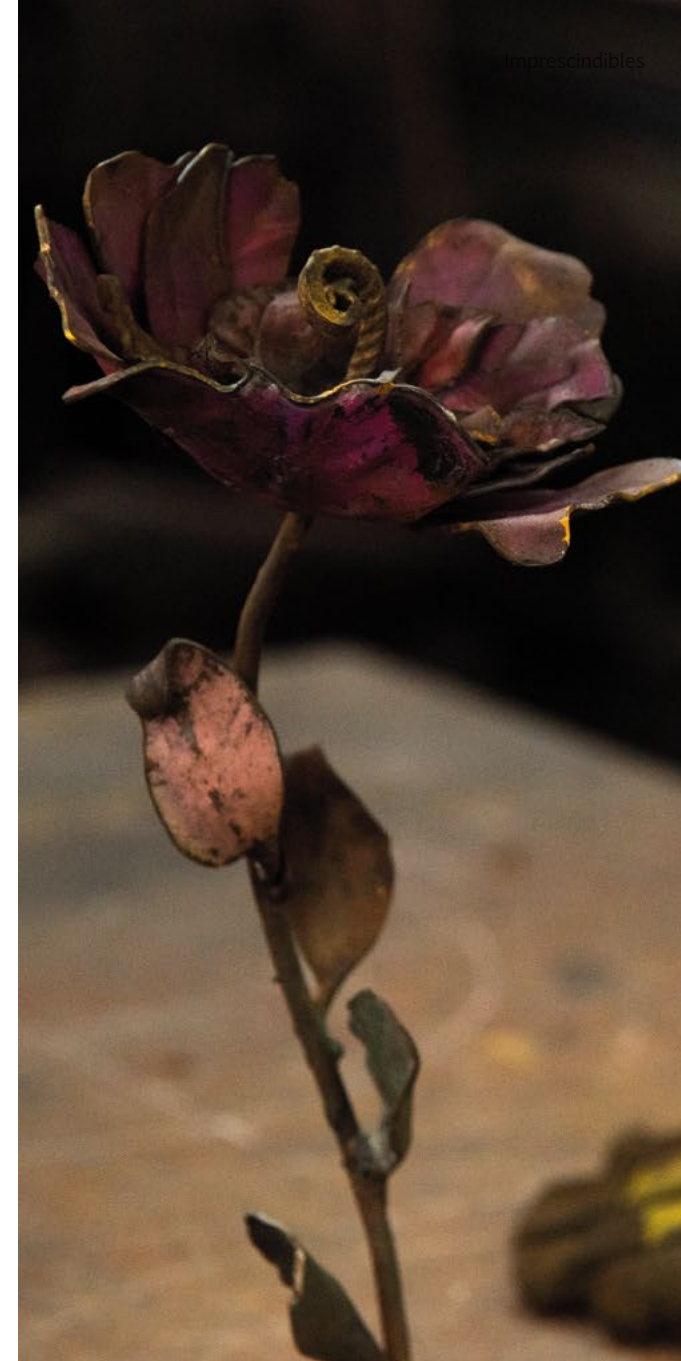
Look out for the iconic verde cobre glaze, that distinctive finish which lends local pieces their unmistakable sheen and tone, the fruit of centuries of almost alchemical experimentation. Every jug, every plate, every botijo (traditional earthenware cooling vessel) is a work of functional art, an authentic keepsake carrying with it the soul of Úbeda's earth.



## *The Echo of the Forge* *An Open-Air Museum*

Úbeda itself is an open-air museum of wrought iron beneath the sky. Artistic ironwork reached its Renaissance peak here, and its creations adorn palace grilles and chapel railings like jewels set into a crown of stone.

To visit a forge is to step into a world of fire and metal, where the rhythmic hammering, the heat of the furnace and the craftsman's skill in bending glowing iron become a sublime lesson in how strength and artistry can move in step.

Gastronomy for the Soul

Úbeda's gastronomy is the purest expression of its identity: cooking shaped by olive groves, by the land and by time itself, turning simplicity into excellence.

### *The Tapas Trail: A Sacred Ritual*

Going out for tapas in Úbeda is something close to sacred, a way of socialising that turns each bar into a stage for everyday life. Order a drink and you will be served a generous tapa, from lomo de orza to ochío con morcilla en caldera, each one a small gesture of genuine hospitality.

Calling at several bars allows you to sample countless local delights while taking part in the real parliament of the people, played out in these spontaneous conversations.




### *The Taste of Memory: Spoon Dishes*

Do not miss the beloved platos de cuchara, the spoon dishes that form the backbone of local cooking and feel like a culinary embrace. Andrajos, a hearty stew of flat pastry strips with vegetables and meat, is deeply comforting on cooler days, while espinacas esparragás and the summer pipirrana salad connect you with the purest essence of Úbeda's table.

### *Convent Sweets: Treasures Behind Cloistered Walls*

Convent baking is another treasure the city keeps close. Seek out alpagates, roscos de Jesús or borrachuelos, a heritage of flavours still alive in enclosed convents and traditional bakeries where recipes are handed down from generation to generation like state secrets.





# *Beyond the Monuments*

Experiences That Stay With You

To understand Úbeda in full, one must step away from the obvious path and tune into its unhurried rhythm and its wise, warm-hearted people.

### *The Viewpoints: Balconies to Infinity*

One of the most breathtaking views opens from the viewpoints along the walls, where the landscape of Úbeda unfolds into an endless horizon of olive trees: Jaén's true "silver sea". Visit at sunset, when golden light washes over the countryside, and the experience will stay with both your eyes and your heart.



### *An Evening Stroll: Enchanted Úbeda*

By night, Úbeda is pure magic: monuments lit like beacons of beauty, cobbled streets taking on an air of mystery, and a hush that allows the city's profound peace to be felt in full. Walking through Plaza Vázquez de Molina under moonlight comes close to the mystical.



*The Olive Experience:  
Communion with the Land*

If you are travelling in autumn or winter, visit a local olive mill, where you can witness the miracle of transformation: from the arrival of the olives to the moment when liquid gold begins to flow from the press. There is no better way to understand the deep bond between the city and the land that sustains it.



*Úbeda: A Conclusion  
Open to Infinity*

Úbeda is a city that reveals itself gradually, like a shy lover who shows her secrets only to those who know how to wait. It is not a destination for modern haste, but for wise contemplation.

Its monuments are the noble facade, yet its true soul lies in the warmth of its people, in the honesty of its food and in the wisdom of its artisans. At the same time, it is also a city of commerce and services, with a lively fabric of traditional shops, family-run businesses, cafés, restaurants and small enterprises that fill its streets with daily activity, turning every walk through Úbeda into a constant encounter between history, everyday life and economic vitality.

It is a city that invites you to slow down, to listen to the stories whispered by its stones, and to savour every moment as one savours freshly pressed golden extra virgin olive oil.
